

Appointment of Lianhe Global CEO to the HKEAA Advisory Committee on International and Professional Examinations Business Development

Dr. Stan Ho, the Chief Executive Officer of Lianhe Ratings Global Limited, was appointed as a member of the Advisory Committee on the International and Professional Examinations Business Development (IPEBD) under the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) effective 15 September 2021.

The HKEAA, established under the Hong Kong Examinations Authority Ordinance Chapter 261 in 1977, is an independent, self-financing statutory body. The major function of the HKEAA is to administer public examinations held in Hong Kong. The IPEBD is the business development arm of the International and Professional Examinations Division (IPE) under the HKEAA. The IPE has administered over 200 international and professional examinations every year since 2015, with a total number of candidates of around 288,300 in 2018/19 and over 162,000 in 2019/20.

The scope of the responsibilities for an IPEBD Advisory Committee member includes advising and recommending the business development opportunities and directions for the IPE, and evaluating the outcomes of the IPE business development projects.
