

Lianhe Global withdraws Huai'an Traffic Holding Group Co., Ltd.'s global scale Long-term Issuer Credit Rating for Commercial Reasons

HONG KONG, 13 June 2025 – Lianhe Ratings Global Limited (“Lianhe Global”), an international credit rating company, has withdrawn the global scale Long-term Issuer Credit Rating of Huai'an Traffic Holding Group Co., Ltd. (“Huai'an Traffic”; ‘BBB+/Stable’). The rating was withdrawn for commercial reasons.

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Lianhe Global is an international credit rating company that provides credit ratings to corporations, banks, non-bank financial institutions, local investment and development companies, and other asset classes around the globe. Lianhe Global also provides credit risk research and other services related to credit ratings.
