

Lianhe Global has affirmed ‘A+’ global scale Long-term Issuance Credit Rating of Sichuan Gloport Investment Development Group Co., Ltd.’s Credit Enhanced Bonds

HONG KONG, 3 August 2026 – Lianhe Ratings Global Limited (“Lianhe Global”), an international credit rating company, has affirmed ‘A+’ global scale Long-term Issuance Credit Rating of the CNY Credit Enhanced Sustainable Bonds (“the Bonds”) issued by Sichuan Gloport Investment Development Group Co., Ltd. (“SGID”; ‘BBB+’/Positive). The Bonds have the benefit of an irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit (“SBLC”) provided by Bank of Shanghai Co., Ltd. (“BOSC”), Chengdu Branch.

A full list of affirmed issuance ratings is included in this press release.

Key Rating Rationales

The Issuance Credit Rating primarily reflects the credit enhancement provided by the irrevocable SBLC issued by BOSC’s Chengdu Branch and underpinned by the credit strength of BOSC. Under the SBLC, BOSC is obligated for any amount that the issuer has failed to pay according to the pre-funding requirements and the full amount of the outstanding principal due and interest accrued on the Bonds in the events of default.

BOSC is a leading city commercial bank in Shanghai and a domestically systemically important bank. We believe BOSC is likely to receive extraordinary government support if needed, given its strategic importance in serving the regional real economy by providing financial services, particularly in Shanghai.

Rating Sensitivities

Any downgrade or upgrade in our internal credit assessment on BOSC would result in a similar rating action on the Bonds.
